- Up to date relevant evidence
- Provision of options for stakeholders to make decision so that its non-partisan.
- Capacity building on use of evidence in programmes success.

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Emphasis on the benefits of use of M and E evidence.

- Demand for accountability and transparency and impact of the policies/programmes
- Justify the budget estimates requests
- Make decision on operational allocations
- Inform further interrogations of the challenges and make decisions on what should be done
- Reports on performance helps to encourage officers to work harder to improve their outputs
- Provide data for legislative needs
- Plays a major role in offering efficient services
- Helps in communication or information to the public to build trust, avoid overlaps and duplication and improvements of outputs.
